Recommended number of doses by 2 years: 3 Hep B, 4 DtaP, 4 Hib, 3 IPV, 4 PCV, 1 MMR, 1 Varicella, and 2 Hep A

Hep A<sup>1</sup>: Second dose administered at 18 to 2 years

HPV<sup>2</sup>: Available ages 9-26 years. Two doses under 15 years of age, 3 doses for those 15 years and up

Influenza (Yearly)<sup>3</sup>: Second dose administered at 18 to 2 years

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
